




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


John was the first member of the Permafrost group of the Division of Building Research, NRC, Ottawa. He joined the Division in 1950 and during the first two years carried out detailed survey of buildings along the Mackenzie. John left the Division about 1962 to become a northern consultant. Unfortunately, he died of a heart attack in 1964 at the beginning of a very promising career.





Hank joined DBR in 1952 as well. He was the structural engineer of the group and carried out detailed observations and surveys of the performance of buildings and other structures in permafrost. These observations were made throughout the north and, in particular, in Inuvik and Thompson. He spent considerable time monitoring the dykes in Northern Manitoba and obtaining information on the performance of anchors in permafrost. Hank died in 1999.







